R28.1447 Rule 447. Parades and processions; permit required; violation as misdemeanor.

(1) A procession or parade, other than a procession or parade of the forces of the United States armed services, the military forces of this state, and the forces of the police and fire departments, shall not occupy, march, or proceed along any roadway, unless pursuant to a permit issued by the Chief of Police and unless the procession or parade is in accordance with other regulations as are set forth in this code. (2) A person who violates this rule is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Rules: (Read and initial each box)

- Individual motor vehicles, or those towing floats, must be operated by a licensed driver.
- Motorized entries shall be operated in a safe and cautious manner.
- Drivers of all entries shall follow directions of Parade Officials, and shall maintain a safe distance between each entry.
- Once in motion, all persons riding on a float or entry shall remain in place, except in the case of a medical or other emergency.
- Passengers on entries shall not throw or cause to be thrown from the entry any articles such as candy or water filled balloons etc.
- In order to obtain a registration for the parade or procession, the individual representing an organization shall be required to sign a Waiver of Liability. ,
