PROJECTS IN 2022

THIS YEAR WE COMPLETED THE REMOVAL OF THE OLD LIGHTPOSTS, AS WELL AS THE INSTALLATION OF 46 NEW ONES, ALONG MAIN STREET AS WELL AS THE POCKET PARK. THIS PROJECT WAS PART OF THE CONTINUED INITIATIVE TO REVITALIZE OUR DOWNTOWN. THE PROJECT COST \$126,800 BUT WILL BE OFFSET SLIGHTLY BY SELLING THE OLD LAMP POSTS - ALL OF WHICH HAVE BEEN CLAIMED!

HOSTED BY THE DDA

THE DDA HOLDS ITS ANNUAL HERITAGE FESTIVAL/CLASSIC CAR SHOW IN SEPTEMBER. THIS YEAR WE HAD 213 CLASSIC CARS AND 20± VENDORS LINING THE STREETS OF DOWNTOWN. WE CANNOT WAIT TO SEE THE TURNOUT IN 2023

ON THE FIRST SATURDAY IN DECEMBER THE DDA HOLDS ITS ANNUAL HOLLY DAY LIGHT PARADE. THE 2022 HOLLY DAY PARADE SAW A RECROD BREAKING 32 PARADE ENTRIES. RESIDENTS LINE THE STREETS WITH THEIR FAMILY AND FRIENDS TO WATCH THE MAGIC AS THE PARADE USHERS IN THE CHRISTMAS SEASON AND SPIRIT INTO THIE DOWNTOWN.

HSTORIC PRESERVATION

FAÇADE GRANTS - THE FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO ENCOURAGE **ECONOMIC INVESTMENT AND REVITALIZATION TO THE COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS WITHIN** THE DDA DISTRICT. THE PROGRAM PROMOTES PHYSICAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE COMMERCIAL FACADES VISIBLE FROM THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY. IT IS THE INTENT OF THE PROGRAM TO STRENGTHEN THE ECONOMIC VITALITY OF DOWNTOWN ALMONT BY IMPROVING THE EXTERIOR PHYSICAL APPEARANCE OF THE BUILDINGS WHILE AT THE SAME TIME PRESERVING AND PROMOTING THE HISTORICAL CHARACTER AND INTEGRITY OF THE BUILDINGS WITHIN THE DISTRICT.




