- This show is open to antique dealers, artists and vendors who offer affordable merchandise that is complementary to our hometown heritage theme. Local produce and flowers are also welcome. Attendees will likely be shopping for affordable treasures in the range of \$5-\$50. Bring a wide selection of merchandise in this range. You may wish to limit the higher priced "Wow" factor items.
- Vendors are placed on either grass or paved surfaces. Please bring the appropriate tent stakes and/or weights to property secure your tent/canopy. Festival staff will not have available tools/equipment to assist in securing your personal items.
- Festival activities are located within the Village of Almont and within walkable distance between events. All vendors will be grouped centrally to maximize exposure for festival goes and to capitalize on planned events.
- Confirmation of receipt of your application will be by phone or email as they are received. Vendor placement will take place as applications are received.
